

FYRESTIKS and FYRESTAFS

Instructions (All Types)

This is not a toy



FYRESTIKS/STAFS are intended for use by experienced Jugglers and, like all fire juggling products, they can be dangerous. The FYRESTIK/STAF should only be used outdoors and under controlled conditions. Do not attempt to use an unlit FYRESTIK/STAF if you have no previous experience. Practice first.

Fuel Type

The FYRESTIK/STAF's internal fuel reservoirs extend the life of the wicking. Apart from changing the *external* wicking, your FYRESTIK/STAF is maintenance-free. It is unnecessary to replace the wicking inside the patented fuel reservoirs. The preferred fuel is lamp oil; alternatively paraffin/kerosene may be used. **Never** use petrol. (Gas).

Conditioning the FYRESTIK/STAF

Only the wicking end of the FYRESTIK/STAF should be soaked in fuel. Light using a long taper and allow to burn for about one minute, then extinguish the flame. Refuel and repeat the above instructions several times. This process will improve the performance of your FYRESTIK/STAF. Become familiar by juggling your FYRESTIK/STAF **unlit**.

Create a clear area in which to perform - 20ft (6 metres) is usually adequate.

Should you experience difficulties, stop juggling immediately and walk **away** from the lit FYRESTIK/STAF.

Storage

Ensure the FYRESTIK/STAF is **cold** and refuelled before storing.

FYRESTIK/STAF - wick replacement

When to replace and fit a wick:

Replace the wick before it appears badly frayed or damaged;

Replace the wick if it appears loose;

Replace the wick if it no longer retains sufficient fuel and burns unevenly.

To replace the wick, simply unscrew the two retainer screws from the main shaft and refit with a FyreFli replacement wick.
